- ▶ The Canadian Francophonie arts and culture sector (outside Quebec) employs over 36,100 people and contributed more than \$6 billion to Canada's GDP in 2025.
- ▶ Our members deliver essential services that expand access to culture, support artists from emerging to professional stages, and foster diverse cultural expression—all while ensuring Francophone communities across Canada continue to thrive.

### A TRUSTED PARTNER

The FCCF works closely with federal partners to address key challenges in artistic and cultural development across the Francophonie, while contributing directly to policy development.

This working relationship is formalized through the *Collaboration Agreement for the Development of Arts and Culture in Francophone Minority Communities in Canada*, co-chaired with Canadian Heritage since 1998.

- ▶ **Ensure predictable and sustained funding across the arts and culture ecosystem** to drive innovation, strengthen organizational capacity, and safeguard Canadian cultural sovereignty.
- ▶ **Position the arts and culture sector as a key driver of sustainable economic and social development**, recognizing that FCCF members provide services that are essential to the vitality of Francophone communities across Canada.
